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**AN ACT Relating to Petition for Review of Incapacity Under Workmen's Compensation Act.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 31, § 38, amended.** Section 38 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

**'Pending a hearing and final decision upon such petition for review, and except in such cases as the employer and employee may reach a new agreement under section 32, the payment of compensation shall not be decreased or suspended unless a certificate of the employer or his insurance carrier stating that the employee has left the State or that his present whereabouts are unknown, or that he has resumed work.'**
