STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Petition for Review of Incapacity Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 38, amended. Section 38 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'Pending a hearing and final decision upon such petition for review, and except in such cases as the employer and employee may reach a new agreement under section 32, the payment of compensation shall not be decreased or suspended unless a certificate of the employer or his insurance carrier stating that the employee has left the State or that his present whereabouts are unknown, or that he has resumed work.'
