IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Exempting Employees of Homes for Children and the Aged from Minimum Wage Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 30, § 132-B, sub-§ III, ¶ D, amended. Paragraph D of subsection III of section 132-B of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 362 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:
 - 'D. Any individual engaged in the activities of a public-supported nonprofit organization or in a program controlled by an educational nonprofit organization or employed in a private nursing home; or employed in a private hospital; or employed by a nonprofit organization operated for the assistance of either children or the aged;
