COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 517, L.D. 715, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Public Ways and Parking Areas at State
Institutions."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of Sec. 7-E and
inserting in its place thereof the following:

'Sec. 7-E Fines. Any person found guilty of violating
any rule or regulation made pursuant to section 7-B shall, upon
conviction, pay a fine as follows:

I. First offense. For the first offense in any calendar
year, a fine of \$1;

II. Second offense. For the second offense in any
calendar year, a fine of \$2;

III. Subsequent offense. For each offense in excess of 2 in
any calendar year, a fine of \$5.

Notwithstanding any other law, the fines and costs of
court paid under this section shall inure to the municipality
in which the proceedings take place.'
