STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Define Plumbing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 25, § 179, sub-§ V, amended. Subsection V of section 179 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - 'V. Plumbing. "Plumbing" is the art of installing in buildings the pipes, fixtures and other apparatus for bringing in the water supply and removing liquid and water-carried wastes, and shall include the necessary water piping and water connections to all types of heating apparatus using water.'
