RESOLVE, Providing for Pension of Louise Gagnon of Fairfield.

Louise Gagnon; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be granted to Louise Gagnon of Fairfield, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Gagnon is a divorcee about 64 years of age. She has no children or relatives to help support her. She formerly ran a grocery store but was put out of business when overpass on route No. 201 in Fairfield was constructed. She is now ill and unable to work.
