AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial Court and Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 103, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of chapter 103 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 370 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows :

'The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of ~~\$14,000~~ \$16,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$15,000~~ \$17,500.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 106, § 2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 68 of chapter 378 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows :

'Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$13,500~~ \$15,000.'

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts to carry out the purposes of this act the sum of \$21,375 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$28,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963; the breakdown of which shall be as follows :
