STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing State to Convey Certain Land to Cumberland County.

State of Maine to convey land in Windham; authorizing. Resolved: That for the purpose of providing land for the erection of a Civil Defense and Public Safety Control Center, the Governor and Council are authorized and directed to convey to the County of Cumberland for the sum of \$1, the interest of the State in a certain lot or parcel of land situated in the Town of Windham in said county, now part of the grounds of the State Reformatory for Men.

Said parcel of land is described as follows: Beginning at the most northerly corner of land of the State of Maine on the southwesterly side of High Street; thence southwesterly following the northwesterly boundary line of land of said State of Maine, 560 feet to a point; thence southeasterly, parallel with the southwesterly line of High Street, 350 feet to a point; thence northwesterly, parallel to the first course, 560 feet to High Street; thence northwesterly by High Street 350 feet to the point of beginning.
