STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Per Diem Compensation for Superior Court Messenger of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XV, amended. The last sentence of subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 267 of the public laws of 1955 and amended by section 3 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall also receive \$11 \$13 per day for court vacation time, service and attendance when said service and attendance are authorized by a Justice of the Superior Court.'
