IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Eliminating Residence Requirements in Public Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 25, § 235, amended. The last sentence of section 235 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

~~'The provisions of sections~~ Sections 234 to 246 inclusive shall, apply to any dependent child who ~~has resided is living~~ is living in the State for one year immediately preceding the application for such aid; ~~or who was born within one year immediately preceding the application, if the parent or other relative with whom the child is living has resided in the state one year immediately preceding the birth of the child at the date of application.'~~

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 25, § 283, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 283 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 365 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

~~'III. Residence. Has resided~~ Is living in the State continuously for + year immediately preceding at the date of the application;'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 25, § 299, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 299 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 365 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

~~'III. Residence. Has resided~~ Is living in the State continuously for + year immediately preceding at the date of the application;'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 25, § 319-F, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 319-F of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 30 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1955 and amended by section 3 of chapter 365 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'III. Residence. ~~Has resided~~ Is living in the State ~~continuously for a year~~ immediately preceding at the date of the application;'
