STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Payments to Law Library at South Paris, Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 135, amended. That part of section 135 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 42 of chapter 363 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to the law libraries of Oxford County, is amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, \$4,250 \$4,500, of which \$2,000 \$2,250 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at South Paris and \$2,250 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at Rumford,'
