STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Plantations Organized Upon Application of Three or More Citizens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 101, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 101 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Copy of proceedings and description of plantation forwarded to Secretary of State. Upon the organization of a plantation, the clerk and assessors shall transmit to the Secretary of State, to be by him recorded, a certified copy of all proceedings had in effecting such organization, including the petition if any, the warrant issued therefor and the return thereon, and the record of the meeting held in pursuance thereof and a written description of the limits of the plantation, and thereupon all laws applicable to organized plantations shall apply to plantations organized as herein provided; but plantations organized upon applications of 3 or more eitizens as above provided shall not be required to pay state or county taxes unless by special order of the Legislature.'
