COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 260, L. D. 777, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Retirement Benefits for Members of the  
Lewiston Fire Department".

Amend said Bill by striking out the Bill in its entirety,  
and inserting in its place thereof the following:

'Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as  
follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XII, § 10, amended. The  
2nd paragraph of section 10 of Article XII of chapter 8 of the  
private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 200 of the  
private and special laws of 1955, is repealed and the following  
enacted in place thereof:

The death of an active member of the department resulting  
from injury or illness incurred in the line of duty shall entitle  
the hereinafter described beneficiaries to pension benefits. If  
such member so meets his death, the pension benefits payable as  
a result thereof shall be the continued payment of 1/2 of the  
salary he was then receiving. The death of a member of the  
department retired under the provisions of this section or Sections  
9 and 11, of this Article, shall entitle the hereinafter described  
beneficiaries to pension benefits. The pension benefits payable  
as a result thereof shall be the continued payment of the full  
pension he was then receiving. In either event such benefits  
shall be paid to his widow until her death or remarriage and if  
there be no such widow, then to his minor child or children in  
accordance with Article XI, Section 21, of this Charter, as amended.
