STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Completion of the York River Project in York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State funds. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$34,500 to the Town of York to aid said town to complete the York River Project, so called. Such appropriation shall not be available until \$69,000 has been appropriated by the Town of York for said project.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

York Harbor, in the Town of York, no longer can provide an adequate number of safe moorings for its permanent fishing fleet and its seasonal influx of pleasure craft, said harbor must be dredged. There is in existence a federal project for the dredging of 2 five-acre mooring areas at York Harbor authorized by Congress, public law 86-645. The Federal Government has appropriated \$391,000 for this project. It is required by Act of Congress that non-federal interests immediately appropriate the sum of \$69,000 for said project. The Town of York at their annual town meeting to be held March, 1961, will be requested to appropriate the sum of \$69,000 and assume other obligations.
