STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Uniforms for Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 151, amended. The last 2 sentences of section 151 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 271 of the public laws of 1959, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof.

'He may require any of said full time deputies and court officials to wear a uniform as prescribed by the Maine Sheriffs' Association to identify themselves as officers of the law. Upon approval of the county commissioner, uniforms required by this section shall be furnished by the county.'
