RESOLVE, in Favor of Clarence Ricker of Clinton.

Clarence Ricker; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$6,000 from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, to be paid to Clarence Ricker, of Clinton, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damages to his crops by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Clarence Ricker claims damage to his crops by deer in 1949. Planted 13 acres of beans and 2 acres of corn and carrots. Feels he should be compensated for damage done by deer.
