IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Burlington for Road Construction.

Town of Burlington; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$12,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 for construction of a gravel road from Burlington to Lincoln, Penobscot County, via Long Ridge. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1963.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

As the Town of Burlington taxes come largely from timberland, the owners put considerable pressure on the town for a permanent, year-round road, to market their timber products.
