SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 594, L. D. 815, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Open Season on Deer in Zone 2."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting after the word and figure "Zone 2" the words and figures ' and Boundaries of Zones 1 and 3'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, §91, amended. The 2nd and 4th paragraphs of section 91 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Zone 1. West of the Penobscot River (west bank) and south and east of a line formed by the north shore of the Piscataquis River, beginning at its mouth in Howland, Penobscot County, thence westerly up the river to route 150 to Guilford, Piscataquis County, thence southwesterly along route 150 to Skowhegan, Somerset County, and thence along route 2 to a point where it crosses the Maine-New Hampshire line. Such area will include those islands in Penobscot Bay which are situated in Waldo and Knox Counties.'

'Zone 3. All that area north of a zone line following route 2 from the point where it crosses the Maine-New Hampshire line to Skowhegan, Somerset County, thence north and east on route 150 to Guilford, Piscataquis County, where it crosses the Piscataquis River, thence easterly along the north shore of this river to its mouth in Howland, Penobscot County, thence northerly along the west bank of the Penobscot River to the junction of the Canadian Pacific Railroad tracks in Mattawamkeag, Penobscot County, thence easterly along the Maine Central Railroad tracks used by the Canadian Pacific Railway to the point where they cross the Canadian border near Vanceboro, Washington County.' "

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
