IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Ratify and Confirm the Incorporation of the Lewiston and Auburn Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Incorporation of the Lewiston and Auburn Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, ratified and confirmed. Incorporation of the Lewiston and Auburn Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, of Lewiston, in the County of Androscoggin and State of Maine, is hereby declared to be in existence, and to have been in existence since February 25, 1885, and all the acts of the members, officers and directors of said corporation, as such prior to the effective date of this act, are hereby ratified and confirmed, and the register of deeds in and for the County of Androscoggin, State of Maine, is hereby authorized and instructed to enter upon his records this validation of the incorporation of the Lewiston and Auburn Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, in accordance with this act.
