RESOLVE, Providing State Pension for Joseph Burrows of Kennebunkport.

Joseph Burrows; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be granted to Joseph Burrows, of Kennebunkport, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Burrows has always been an active participant in all town affairs and had been a good provided for his family until he was injured by falling from a scaffolding while at work. Since his accident which has left him crippled he has been unable to obtain a job and this pension is needed to assist in maintaining his home.
