STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Charles Wildes of Kennebunkport.

Charles Wildes; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$100 per month be granted to Charles Wildes of Kennebunkport to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative benefits. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles Wildes is an elderly man and is presently a patient at the Augusta State Hospital.

By virtue of this fact, he is apparently not eligible for any other type of public aid.

This resolve is presented to provide for some measure of assistance to his needy family.
