IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Increase Retirement Benefit of Cora B. Littlefield of Kennebunk.

Cora B. Littlefield; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit presently being paid to Cora B. Littlefield of Kennebunk, be increased to \$185 per month, effective as of January 1, 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Cora B. Littlefield taught in the public schools of Maine for over 50 years and retired in May of 1954 on a monthly retirement benefit of \$133.76.

Miss Littlefield was born in May of 1884, is obviously an aged person and in need of additional income in her declining years.
