STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Increase Retirement Benefit for Chaplain T. Greene of Princeton.

Chaplain T. Greene; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Chaplain T. Green, of Princeton, under chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes be increased to \$25 per month effective as of January 1, 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Greene retired in 1947 on a monthly benefit of \$10.14. He is nearly 85 years old.

Up until recently, both his son and daughter have been helping support him, but now the daughter is no longer able to do so. Mr. Greene owns his home but has little or no other income.
