COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 598, L. D. 865, Resolve,
Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Penobscot County.

Amend said Resolve by striking out everything after the
title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Fishing in certain waters in Penobscot County; regulated.'

RESOLVED: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and
Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation
that there shall be a daily bag limit of 5 trout taken from
Messer Pond and Little Messer Pond in T5, R8, Penobscot County.
Bowlin Pond, T5, R8, Penobscot County, shall be restricted to
the use of wet or dry flies only, used in the usual manner,
without bait.'
