RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Penobscot County.

Fishing in certain waters in Penobscot County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation that there shall be a daily bag limit of 5 trout taken from the East Branch of the Penobscot River and all waters running directly into it from Whetstone Falls in T. 3, R. 7, to Grand Lake Matagamon in T. 6, R. 8; Atwood Pond; Kimball Pond; Bowlin Pond; Messer Pond; Little Messer Pond in T. 5, R. 8; Hathorn Pond; Little Hathorn Pond and Lost Pond in T. 4, R. 8. The East Branch of the Penobscot River, from Whetstone Falls in T. 3, R. 8, to Grand Lake Matagamon in T. 6, R. 8, and Bowlin Pond, T. 5, R. 8, shall be restricted to the use of wet or dry flies only, used in the usual manner, without bait. All brooks and streams running into Bowlin Pond, T. 5, R. 8, shall be closed at all times to all fishing.
