Amend said Amendment in the 4th line by inserting after the
word "Million" the words 'Twenty-Five Thousand'

Further amend said Amendment in the 16th line by striking out
the figure "\$1,000,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure
'\$1,025,000'

Further amend said Amendment in section 6 by adding a new
paragraph 12 to read as follows:

'12. Vaughn Memorial Park - South Berwick	\$25,000

This sum will be used to develop said park which was given to the
State of Maine.'

Further amend said Amendment in the 11th line of section 8
by inserting after the word "Million" the words 'Twenty-Five Thousand'
