STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for In-School Educational Telecasting.

Department of Education; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$60,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the cost of operating the television station at the University of Maine in telecasting educational programs approved by the Commissioner of Education at the elementary or secondary level.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Educational programs and courses designed to enrich or extend the curriculum at the elementary or secondary level would be telecast by the University of Maine. This appropriation would provide for the operation of the University of Maine television station for this purpose.
