IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing State Highway Commission to Study Feasibility of a Bridge Across the Damariscotta River.

State Highway Commission authorized to make study. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission is authorized and directed to make a study of the feasibility and cost of a proposed bridge across the Damariscotta River from Boothbay to South Bristol, in the County of Lincoln; and be it further

Resolved: That the commission shall report the results of its study at the next regular session of the Legislature.
