HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 309, L. D. 897, Bill, "An Act Relating to Inspection of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following section:

"Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, §41-C, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 41-C, to read as follows:

'Sec. 41-C. Spinner hubcaps prohibited. No person shall equip his motor vehicle with or use any spinner hubcap or similar device which projects beyond the length of the hubcap originally installed on such vehicle on the public ways contrary to this section or contrary to the rules and regulations of the Secretary of State.'"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 1 to 4 to be 2 to 5.
