STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Assaults Upon Enforcement Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 135, § 21, amended. The last sentence of section 21 of chapter 135 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
