

## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 100th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 295, L. D. 906, Bill, "An Act

Relating to Zoning in the City of Lewiston".

Amend said Bill by striking out Sec. 3 thereof in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Building inspector. The board of appeals shall appoint a building inspector and shall prescribe his duties and tenure of office. Said board shall set his salary subject to the approval of the board of finance and he shall receive no other compensation or emoluments for the performance of his official duties. He shall issue building permits and receive fees therefor, <u>in accor-</u> <u>dance with the requirements of the zoning ordinance. He shall account</u> <u>monthly under oath and pay over to the City Treasurer all fees</u> <u>received by him for building permits or payable to him by virtue of</u> his office which may be receivable by the City.'
