RESOLVE, to Increase Retirement Benefit for Susie H. Yeaton, of Harrington.

Retirement benefit of Susie H. Yeaton; increased. Resolved: That the retirement benefit now being paid to Susie H. Yeaton, of Harrington, under the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A, be increased by the amount of \$25 per month, effective as of January 1, 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Susie H. Yeaton retired under the so-called "non-contributory" teachers retirement law in December of 1940 on an annual retirement benefit then provided for under the law for teachers with at least 25 years of service of \$275 a year.

At the present time, due to increases being granted to this particular group of teachers over the years, she is receiving the sum of \$1,050 per year.

This lady was born on January 15, 1881 and due to her advanced age and resulting illness, is in need of additional income; thence the reason for introducing this resolve. She has been in the hospital twice in the last year.
