COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 716, L.D. 915, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Speed of Commercial Vehicles and School Buses."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. R.S., c. 22, §113, sub-§II, ¶F, repealed and
replaced. Paragraph F of subsection II of section 113 of
chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 2
of chapter 149 of the public laws of 1959, is repealed and the
following enacted in place thereof:

'F. School buses shall not be operated at a
speed in excess of 45 miles per hour, except
that when used for purposes of an educational
trip or for transporting pupils to and from any
extra-curricular activity a school bus may be
operated at a speed not exceeding 50 miles per
hour;' "
