STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Certain Trailers and Truck Tractors on Four-Lane Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ III, amended. The 5th paragraph from the end of subsection III of section 16 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 308 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Only one trailer or semi-trailer shall be drawn by a motor vehicle, except that on a 4-lane divided highway a combination of straight truck and 4-wheel trailer or a truck tractor, semi-trailer and 4-wheel trailer may be permitted not to exceed 98 feet in length and not to exceed a gross weight of 127,400 pounds. All vehicles so used shall be equipped with adequate brakes on all axles and adequate coupling devices in accordance with Interstate Commerce Commission safety regulations.'
