STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Payments to County Law Libraries in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 135, amended. That part of section 135 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 91 of the public laws of 1957, which relates to the payments to Aroostook law library, is further amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, \$3,300 \$4,300 of which \$2,200 \$3,200 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Houlton in said county and \$1,100 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Caribou in said county.'
