## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Sagadahoc County and Judge and Recorder of Bath Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 13th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Sagadahoc County, is amended to read as follows:

'Sagadahoc County; County commissioners, \$1,000 \$1,150; clerk of courts, \$3,340 \$4,300; county attorney, \$2,500 \$3,300; treasurer, \$4,600 \$1,750; sheriff, \$4,100 \$4,500; register of deeds, \$3,150 \$4,300; judge of probate, \$2,650 \$3,650; register of probate, \$2,250 \$3,250; Bath municipal court judge, \$3,300 \$3,450; recorder, \$2,500 \$3,000.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$800 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney of Sagadahoc County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
