RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Long Range Capital Improvement Planning at the State Teachers' Colleges and the State Normal School.

Long range capital improvement planning at the State Teachers' Colleges and the State Normal School; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund, in favor of the Department of Education, the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962, for the purpose of securing engineering, architectural and related educational consultant services for the development of over-all long range plans for capital improvements at the State Teachers' Colleges and Normal School.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In compliance with the Revised Statutes, chapter 15-A, section 25, subsection I, the State Teachers' Colleges and Normal School have been asked to submit long range programs of capital improvement needs to the State Bureau of Public Improvements.

Although some funds for securing outside architectural and engineering services for the various teachers' colleges have been made available from the State's Construction Reserve Account, it is now apparent that these funds are insufficient to provide adequate analysis and planning. The requested appropriation will provide for complete master planning of the entire campus, plant, facilities and services at each of the five state teacher preparation institutions. This planning will include projected additions and improvements to programs and facilities as well as a survey of existing facilities, and it will provide for the presentation and coordination of all information in graphic and readily accessible form.
