STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Irving L. Leach of Bluehill.

Irving L. Leach; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,291.48 to be paid to Irving L. Leach, of Bluehill, as full and final settlement of his claim against the State for losses sustained during August, 1959 when a tractor and mower which he was trucking collided with a tree limb in North Brooksville which the State Highway Commission left overhanging Route 176 and were dragged from the truck and demolished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Damages sustained by Mr. Leach as a result of the failure of the State Highway Commission to remove the overhanging tree limb with which the load in his truck collided includes the total loss of a Super A Farmall Tractor and attached Hi-Way Mower valued at \$1,291.48. Mr. Leach has never been compensated for this damage.
