Millinocket Community Hospital; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$121.50 to be paid to the Millinocket Community Hospital, of Millinocket, for hospitalization for Theodore Gerald, of Stacyville.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Theodore Gerald was arrested in Stacyville for drunkenness and crawled out a rear window of the State Police patrol car which was taking him to the Millinocket jail. He received treatment for the resulting injuries at the Millinocket Community Hospital which has not been reimbursed.
