**RESOLVE, in Favor of John McVay of Millinocket.**

**John McVay; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$22 to be paid to John McVay, of Millinocket, for guarding a jail prisoner during his period of hospitalization at the Millinocket Community Hospital.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Theodore Gerald was arrested in Stacyville for drunkenness and crawled out the rear window of a State police patrol car which was taking him to the Millinocket jail. Mr. McVay, of the Millinocket police, who served as one of his guards during his hospitalization has not been compensated for guarding Gerald, since both the town and county refuse to pay.
