RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Charles F. Moore of Auburn.

Retirement benefit granted to Mrs. Charles F. Moore. Resolved: That the amount of the retirement benefit, namely, \$33.65 monthly, formerly paid to the late Charles F. Moore, be paid to his widow, Mrs. Charles F. Moore, effective as of January 1, 1961.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The late Charles F. Moore was a faithful employee of the State Forestry Department for over 20 years. This length of service, combined with the relatively low salary paid to him during his service, resulted in a monthly retirement benefit of only \$33.65. It is alleged that Mr. Moore furnished the State much of the equipment used in connection with his service as a fire warden and at no cost to the State.

Mrs. Moore has very little other income and needs the amount requested in this resolve to maintain herself in her own home.
