RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Lakes in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties.

Fishing in certain lakes in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Millinocket Lake, T. 1, R. 8; Pemadumcook Lake; Upper Twin Lake; South Twin Lake; Ambajejus Lake; Chesuncook Lake; Caribou Lake; Ripogenus Lake and Upper Jo-Mary Lake, in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties, to ice fishing for all fish except bass from January 1st to March 31st.
