IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Cupsuptic Lake, Oxford County.

Fishing in Cupsuptic Lake regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait; the daily limit shall be 5 fish except that from September 16th to September 30th, annually, the daily limit shall be one fish.
