**AN ACT Relating to Determination of Quorum at Special Town Meetings
in Kittery.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Determination of quorum. At the time set forth in the warrant for the special town meeting, the town clerk shall ascertain if a quorum is present by appointing 2 or more persons to actually count the number of voters present and make their returns to him. If it is found that a quorum is present, the meeting will proceed with the first article. If it is found that a quorum is not present, the town clerk will make the fact known and declare the meeting dissolved.
