STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to State Valuation of Town of Bristol for School Subsidies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of Bristol; valuation for school subsidies. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the state valuation for the Town of Bristol, Lincoln County, as determined under the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 16, section 67, shall remain the amount as determined by the Board of Equalization and filed in the office of the Secretary of State in 1958 for the purposes of any state subsidy to the Town of Bristol for educational and school purposes.
