RESOLVE, Designating Island in Little Sebago Lake as "Dav Brien Island."

Island in Little Sebago Lake designated. Resolved: That the island lying in Little Sebago Lake, in the Town of Gray, Cumberland County, designated as Lot No. 42 on the plan of said town drawn by Wright & Pierce of Topsham in 1955, and filed in the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds as Plan No. LS 7, be officially named and referred to as "Dav Brien Island."
