COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 700, L.D. 978, Bill, "An
Act Regulating Emergency Calls on Party Lines."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the amending
clause and inserting in place thereof the following amending
clause:

'R.S., c. 131, §§36-A-36-C, additional. Chapter 131 of
the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by
adding 3 new sections to be numbered 36-A to 36-C, to read
as follows:'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the
underlined section 36-C.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line
the underlined figure and letter "36-C" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined figure and letter '36-B'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 28th
and 29th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 36-C. Penalty for violation. Whoever violates
sections 36-A to 36-B shall be punished by a fine of not
more than \$300 or'
