## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Granting Additional Retirement Benefits to Erna G. Adams of Bridgton.

Teacher's pension for Erna G. Adams. Resolved: That Erna G. Adams of Bridgton be given credit for an additional 8 years of teaching service so that she may be entitled to an additional retirement benefit under the Revised Statutes, chapter 63-A.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Adams is 75 years of age and has 31 years of teaching service. Credit for 10 years teaching in New Brunswick is asked for to permit a larger retirement benefit.
