# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Taking Clams from Batson's River in the Town of Kennebunkport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1959, c. 154, Chapter A, § 4, sub-§ V, amended.** Subsection V of section 4 of Chapter A of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1959, as enacted by section 4 of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'V. Taking clams from Batson's River in the Town of Kennebunkport. From October 1,  $\frac{1959}{1961}$  to October 1,  $\frac{1964}{1963}$ , no clams shall be dug or taken from the flats in Batson's River or in any of its branches or tributaries, in the Town of Kennebunkport, except that, during said 2-year period, any resident or property owner of said town may dig from said flats not to exceed 2 pecks of clams at one tide.'
