IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to School Sessions on Saturdays and Sundays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 32, amended. The last paragraph of section 32 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘Five days constitute the school week and 4 weeks a school month, but no school sessions shall be held on Saturdays and Sundays.’
